

Frequently Asked Questions

Models

1. Is this a Modeling Agency?

No, we are a 3 day modeling program.

2. How do I know if I've been accepted?

We will notify you via email on the status of your application.

3. Do I get to keep the photos?

Yes, once you have sold all of your tickets you will receive both your neon and white background photos. You will also receive runway photos from the show as well.

4. What do I bring to Photo Shoot and Coaching sessions?

Please reference our "How to Prep" email sent out right before coaching and photo shoot day.

5. How do I sell tickets if I am out of state?

We encourage you to reach out to friends and family for support as well as post on social media sites.

6. I purchased a ticket but for some reason do not see it in my ticket count, why is that?

Please give us a call or an email and have the ticket order number ready.

7. Why am I selling tickets to model?

As you may know The Model Experience is a service, from Back to Back Photo Shoots to Elite Model Coaching and more. We provide a bundle of services valued over \$2000 which are covered through ticket sales.

8. Is there compensation?

No, there is not.

9. When and how am I receiving my photos?

Once you've sold all 10 tickets, we will send you your photos via email after 7 business days from the date of the shoot.

10. Where is the fashion show, coaching session, and photo shoots taking place?

All events are taking place at the Los Angeles Convention Center.

11. Can I do my own hair and makeup for the show?

Yes, we will have reference guides for you to follow closer to the date of the show.

12. How many times am I walking down the runway?

Every model walks once, for one designer.

13. Who am I walking for?

We will notify you of your designer the day of the show.

Guests

1. What is the age range to attend the show?

All ages are welcomed, however each guest requires a ticket.

2. What do I do if I purchased the wrong show time?

This is no problem, please notify the ticket counter on the day of the show and we will fix this for you.

3. What is the seating arrangements for the guests?

General Admission is open seating (2nd row and beyond), VIP tickets include front row seating. Guests will get the opportunity to sit together. We recommend that guests enter together however if they need to save a couple of seats for fellow guests it will not be an issue.

4. How long is the show duration?

Show time usually lasts 1 to 1.5 hours.

5. Am I able to take picture/ videos during the show?

Yes, with phones only. Please remain seated during the show.
